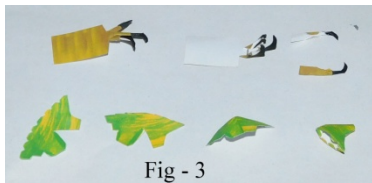
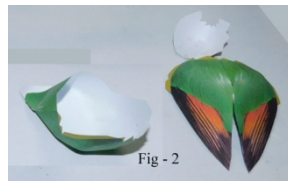
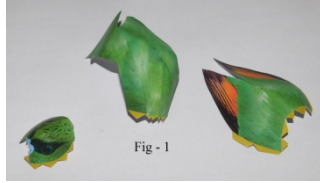


Before assembly study the final scene and keep in mind- It will help in Assembly

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Assembly Instruction

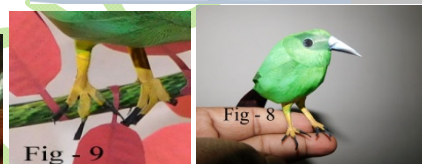
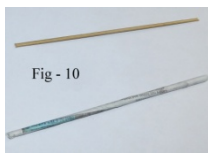


1) Complete inner tabs of 'W', 'C'(take care to join '1' with '1'), 'B' & 'H' (Fig -1). (If you wish,

you may take extra eyes and make a small cut through black line and join to give a raised view. Paste it over eyes of piece 'H'.

- 2) Now Glue and join back to back 'W' with 'W1' and 'T' with 'T1'.
- 3) Now fix Beak ('B') with Head ('H'). Fix 'W' with 'C' through the point '2' & '3'.
- 4) Fix Head with completed body and insert the Tail ('T') at appropriate place (Fig 4)
- 5) Now complete 'K' , 'N' & 'M' (Fig -3)

Assembly Instruction for complete scene



(if you can print back to back then print 'Leaf Back-1' on back of 'Leaf Front' with pieces of 'Leaf front'.)

otherwise cut and glue 'Leaf Back' pieces

- 6) Take 4 wooden stick (like toothpick) of size approx 15 cm and wrap some rough paper (Fig -8) to make legs.
- 7) Make two small holes on each bird. After applying some glue at the end of stick, insert these wooden stick through the Leg Support ('K') in both the birds (Fig-4).
- 8) **Making Stand:-** Join 'P1' with 'P2' and glue 'G2' & 'G3' in the inner side of this (Fig - 5).
- 9) Fix 'G1' at bottom and make tree branches as per your imagination and fix with Pot (reference Fig - 6). Fix 'Leaves' as per your choice.
- 10) Make two small holes each in tree branches for both the birds and insert the wooden stick (completed in Fig-4) through these holes. Cut out any extra length of wooden stick. Now take it out and apply some glue on end of wooden stick and fix the birds (Fig- 7).
- 11) Fix completed 'N' & 'M' on legs (Fig - 9) to complete the claws.

There are some extra pieces, which you may require (in case)
