Assembly Instruction











1) Complete the internal tabs of Head and Upper Beak. Head can be completed by joining line 'aa' with 'aa1' and 'bb' with 'bb1'. Now first fix the Lower Beak and





then Upper Beak (Fig -1). Join "Neck' with 'Head' by aligning Green Dot of Head and Neck.

2) Glue back to back 'RW' with 'RW1' and 'LW' with LW1'. Now put some glue on yellow dots of RW and LW and join these with RWT and LWT. Ref Fig -2a

- 3) Complete the Body by joining all internal Tabs of 'Body'. Fig 2b
- 4) Join LWT and RWT with body through line 1,2,3 & 4 (Fig 2c). Fix Head with Body (Fig-3a).
- 5) Complete Internal Tab of 'Tail Support' and fix this with Body. Glue back to back 'T' with 'T1' and insert it through 'Tail Support' (Fig-3). Take 2 thin wooden sticks and wrap it with rough paper. After completing Internal Tabs of 'LC' inert the stick into it (Fig-7).
- 6) Make 2 holes in Body and after putting some glue on the end of sticks, insert the wooden stick into it. Take a small piece of thermo-coal/ foam and wrap it with 'Ground' (Fig-6) to mage stand. After fixing 'C' & 'C1' with stick as per Fig-5, after putting some glue on the end of sticks, insert it in to stand.
