Inner',TF1, & TF2 (TF-Inner should be glued in reverse direction). Glue 'TF' and 'TF-Inner' back to back. Glue 'TF1' over 'TF' and 'TF2'on 'TF1' (in these cases Green Dot should match). Complete the Internal tabs of 'Collor' and 'Tail Base' (Fig-2).

- 3. Complete Internal tabs of 'Head' (Fig-3a).
- 4. Complete beak by joining 'LB' & ÚB' through the point '1' & '2'

(by putting some glue on yellow dot of UB). Complete Head by completing Internal Tabs 'X1' & 'X2'. Now fix Beak with Head (Fig-3). Now Glue "Collor" with head through the line '8' (Fig-3; make sure that the Black portion of Head & Collor matches).

- 5. Optional:- Take the 'Eyes' provided and make a cut along with black line. Re-join it by over-lapping and applying some glue (to give it raised look). Fix these eyes over the eyes of head.
- 6. Complete all Internal tabs of "Body' & 'Body Top". Join 'Body' with 'Body Top' through the Tab 4 & 6. (Fig-4).
- 7. Glue back to back 'RW'& 'LW' with 'RW-Inner' and 'LW-Inner'. After putting some glue dots on Yellow Dots of LW & RW, slide them under 'Body Top' (Fig-5). Position it in such a way that pattern on LW & RW matches with Body Top.
- 8. Fix 'FB' (Crown) on Head. (optional: Glue 'FBC' on Head so that no gap is visible. Trim it slightly for better look) (Fig-6). Glue Head with Body.
- 9. Join Tail base with Body (Fig-7a) and then glue Tail Fin with this (Fig-7b).
- 10. Complete 'Bar' and then glue 'BC' on both side of it. Complete stands (cut and remove the grey portion) (Fig-8).
- 11. Fix Stands on a card board piece and place the 'Bar' on top of it (Fig-9).
- 12. Complete Internal Tabs of Leg Cover ("CB"). Make small holes on Body and after putting some glue Fix "CB" on this. Take 2 wooden stick of size 10 cm and wrap with some rough paper. After putting some glue on the top of it, insert these stick into the bird through "CB" (fig-10).
- 13. Complete the "C" and "C1" tips and then fix these with wooden stick (Fig-11 a).
- 14. Make two holes on 'Bar' and insert the wooden stick on this (Fig-11b). If the bird does not sit properly, cut short the wooden stick slightly (Fig-11b). Now Put some glue on "C" & "C1" and fix it with 'Bar'. (Fig-12).
- 15. Repeat the same with 2nd bird.
