

3. Now Join 'Left wing' with 'Left Wing -1', by applying some glue dots on

Left Wing-1 and gluing it with Left Wing as per Fig-2.

- 4. Now join parts of Main Body (No 8,9,10,11) through the line 'A','B','C' and 'D'. Now take R-Leg-1 and L-Leg-1 and cut it in such a way (approximately up to the Green Arrow mark), that it look like hairs.(Ref Fig-3).
- 5. Now Insert L-Leg in L-Leg-1 and R-Leg in R-Leg-1 (Fig-3). Now take "Main Body" and join 'L-Leg' and 'R-Leg' with it (reference point is Green Dot . (Fig-3)
- 6. Now take the Eyes and cut and glue along Black Line to give it a raised look. Now fix these Eyes with Head (on Eye place). Now after gluing 'Upper Beak' with 'Upper Beak Inner' (back to back) join this with 'Head'. Now join 'Neck Cover' with 'Head' (ref point is Green Dot and ref Fig is 4)
- 7. Now join 'Neck -1' with and then 'Neck' with it through the line 'N1' (ref point is Green Dot and ref Fig is 5A)
- 8. Join completed 'Neck' with 'Body' (Fig-5B) (the green dot of 'Neck' should match 'Green Dot' of 'piece-9'). Now apply some glue on 'N2' line of 'Neck-1' and place the complete 'Head' on this (Fig-5C)
- 9. Now join parts of Main Body (No 14,15,16,17) through the line 'A1', 'B1', 'C1' and 'D1'. (Fig-6A). Now join this with main body (the Red Dot of 'piece-14' should match Red dot of 'Piece-9')(Fig-6B).
- 10. Now complete Inner tabs of 'Tail' and fix it with body (yellow dot of 'Piece-14' should match yellow dot of 'Tail') (Fig-6C). Complete Tail Fin by gluing 'Tail Fin' with 'Tail Fin Inner' back to back. Fix this Tail Fin with Tail (Fig-6D).
- 11. Bend all 'Blue Dotted' tabs of 'Left Wing 1' and 'Right Wing 1' towards back and apply some glue. Fix the wings with 'Body'. The location of 'Red Arrow'- 'ZL' & 'ZR' of Wings and 'Neck' should align (Fig-8).
- 12. Complete the Claws as per Fig-7. Now take 2 thin wooden stick of size approximately 15 cm and insert in body through leg (Fig-9A).
- 13. Complete the 'Tree Trunk' and glue 'TT' on it (cut and remove any extra portion on TT). Fix it on a Card Board (slightly thick to take load of bird Fig-11). Make two small holes on the 'TT' at a distance of approximately 4 cm. Place the bird on Tree Trunk by inserting wooden stick on 'TT' (Fig-9B). Position the bird at a suitable posture and mark the point of wooden stick. Take out the bird and cut the extra wooden stick.
- 14. With the help of glue fix wooden stick with leg (slightly press at the point marked with red arrow for proper fix). Glue the Claws ('C' & 'C1') with the L-Leg and R-Leg.
- 15. Put some glue on Claws and fix it with tree truck to give a better look. (Fig-12).
