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Assembly Instruction for both Styles



1. **Inner tabs** = they join within the same piece.

External Tabs = (having a black dot) they join one piece with other piece.

2. Complete all inner tabs of all the items. Some of

them are showing in Fig-1 & Fig-2.

3. Complete the 'UB (Upper Beak)' and 'LB (Lower Beak)' (cut the remove the light grey portion- it is only for making Beak boundaries visible). On the completed 'Head' first fix the 'lower beak' and then the 'upper beak' (Fig-2).
4. **Optional:-** Take the 'Eyes' provided and make a cut along with black line. Re-join it by overlapping and applying some glue (to give it raised look). Fix these eyes over the eyes of head.

5. Now take 'N', 'N1', 'N2', 'N3' and 'N4' and after completing their internal tabs, join them one after the other. (while joining the red dots should match). Fig-3
6. Now complete the Inner Tabs of 'Body' and "Body Top'. Apply glue of 'Red line mark' of 'Body Top' and on Red Line of 'Body' and fix 'Body Top' with Body. Now join N4 with Body. The yellow dot and pink dot should match. Join this completed body with 'Neck' completed in step -5 . Fig-3.
7. Now complete the Inner Tabs of Tail and Fix with Body.
8. Take 'Crest' and 'Crest1' and glue them back to back. Fix it with Head.
9. Glue back to back 'R1' with 'R-FF2' and 'L1' with 'L-FF2'.
10. Now complete 'R-FF', 'R-FF1' and 'R-FF2' as per Fig-5. Now complete 'L-FF', 'L-FF1' and 'L-FF2'
11. Take the fins 'F' make some cuts as per Fig-12. After applying some glue at the tips (the narrow portion) of 'F', insert these in between 'Body' and 'Body Top'. Fig-6 and Fig-11.
12. Fix part completed in step-10 to Body. Fig-7.
13. Complete 'Leg' & 'Leg 1' and after gluing them together fix with Body' Fig-8. Take 2 this wooden strip (15 cm in length) and insert it into the Body through Leg. Leaving approximately 2 cm from Leg1, cut the balance portion of wooden strip.
14. Take 'C' and slightly bend the edges. Complete Claws 'C' & 'C1' by joining their tips as per 'Blue Arrow'. Trim any mismatch portion and touch up with black color.
15. Fix these 'C' & 'C1' with 'Leg1' Fig-9.
16. Make a 'Stand' of thermo-Cole and apply some glue on the end of wooden stick and insert it into stand (Fig-10).
17. Now apply some glue on 'C' and 'C1' and fix it with stand (Fig-10).
18. There are some extra pieces also (in case you need it).

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
