Assembly Instruction for all four Styles

The assembly instruction for all the birds are same.










- 1) Complete inner tabs of all the pieces (some are shown in Fig-1 and Fig -3). Glue back to back 'E' with 'E1'; EE with EE1; F with F1; FF with FF1, G with G1 and trim slightly if any white portion of paper is visible (Fig 1).
- 2) To make tail fix the piece 'T' with the tail fin (mode by bluing G with G1) (Fig -2).





- 3) Now fix the Beak ('B') ['B1' is 10% bigger than 'B' choice is yours] with Head and then Head to the Main Body (joint near red dot of body should match with red dot of head) Fig-4;
 - 4) Take 'EE' (already glued with 'EE1') and

put some glue dots at the corner. Slide it under piece 'E' (already glued with 'E1') to complete the 'LEFT WING' (Fig – 5). Repeat the same with 'F' to complete RIGHT WING.

- 5) Now fix the Left & Right Wings at cut mark of * & ** accordingly (Fig − 6A) and Tail to Main Body (joint near green dot of body should match with green dot of tail) Fig- 6B.
- 6) Complete up to this step for all the four birds








Assembly Instruction for complete scene

1) Take piece 107 & 108 and join with the edge 'Z1' & 'Z2'. Glue the 109 at the inner side on pot and 110 at the bottom to complete the pot (Fig – 7).

2) By gluing at one edge of 101,102,103 & multiple pieces of 106, roll them and join with other edge to complete the pieces as per Fig - 7 & Fig - 8.

- 4) Fix the 101 with the POT (Fig 9).
- 5) After applying some glue fix 102 & 103 through the hole 'ZZ' on main trunk. Fix 106 here and there.
- 6) Now take 8 thin wooden sticks (like tooth pick) of size 7 cm each. Wrap a rough paper around it (Fig 10)
- 7) Insert on two stick the piece 'J' & 'K' through this stick (Fig 12 A). Make a small hole at point 'X' of the Bird and after putting some glue insert the stick in the Bird (fig -12B). 8) Make 2 small hole in the trunk (place of your choice) and after putting some glue, insert the bird wooden stick in the trunk (Fig 14). The end portion of 'J' & 'K' should be approximately 5 mm away from trunk surface (You may have to adjust the size of the wooden stick accordingly).
 - 9) Now complete L & M as per Fig- 16. By putting some glue at the top of 'L' and 'M' fix it as per Fig 15. Size of 'L' and 'M' may be adjusted based on your fixing of bird.

Making Flower (free optional): - (Fig - 8) (Fig - 13). There is 3 sheets of flower. If you can print back to back and then use 'Flower - 1' and 'Flower-2' to make flowers. If you cannot print back to back, then use 'Flower - 1' and 'Flower-3' and after cutting glue to fix back to back.
